

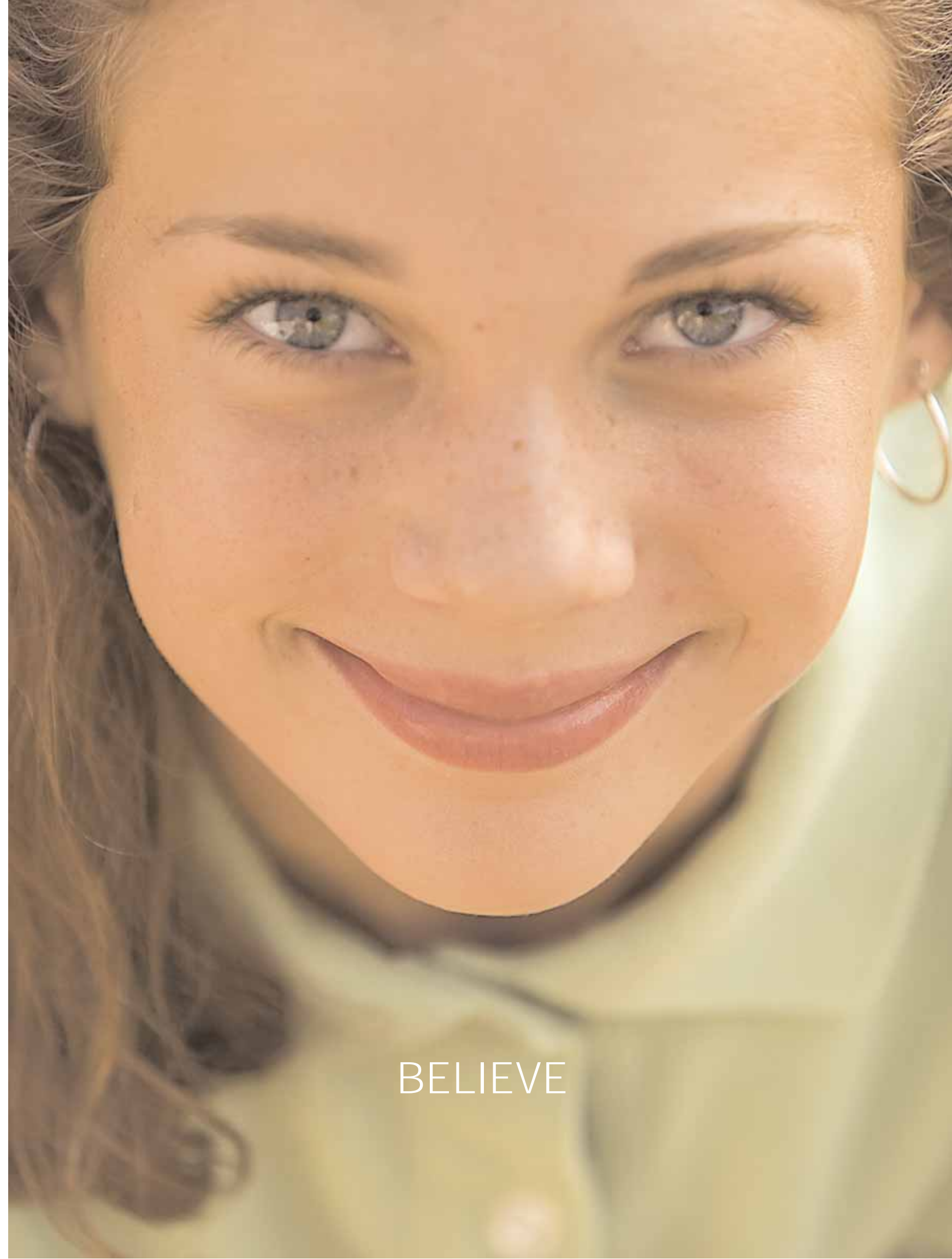

While our scoreboards are impressive, true athletic success at Landmark is measured by the Christian character developed in our athletes. All else fades.

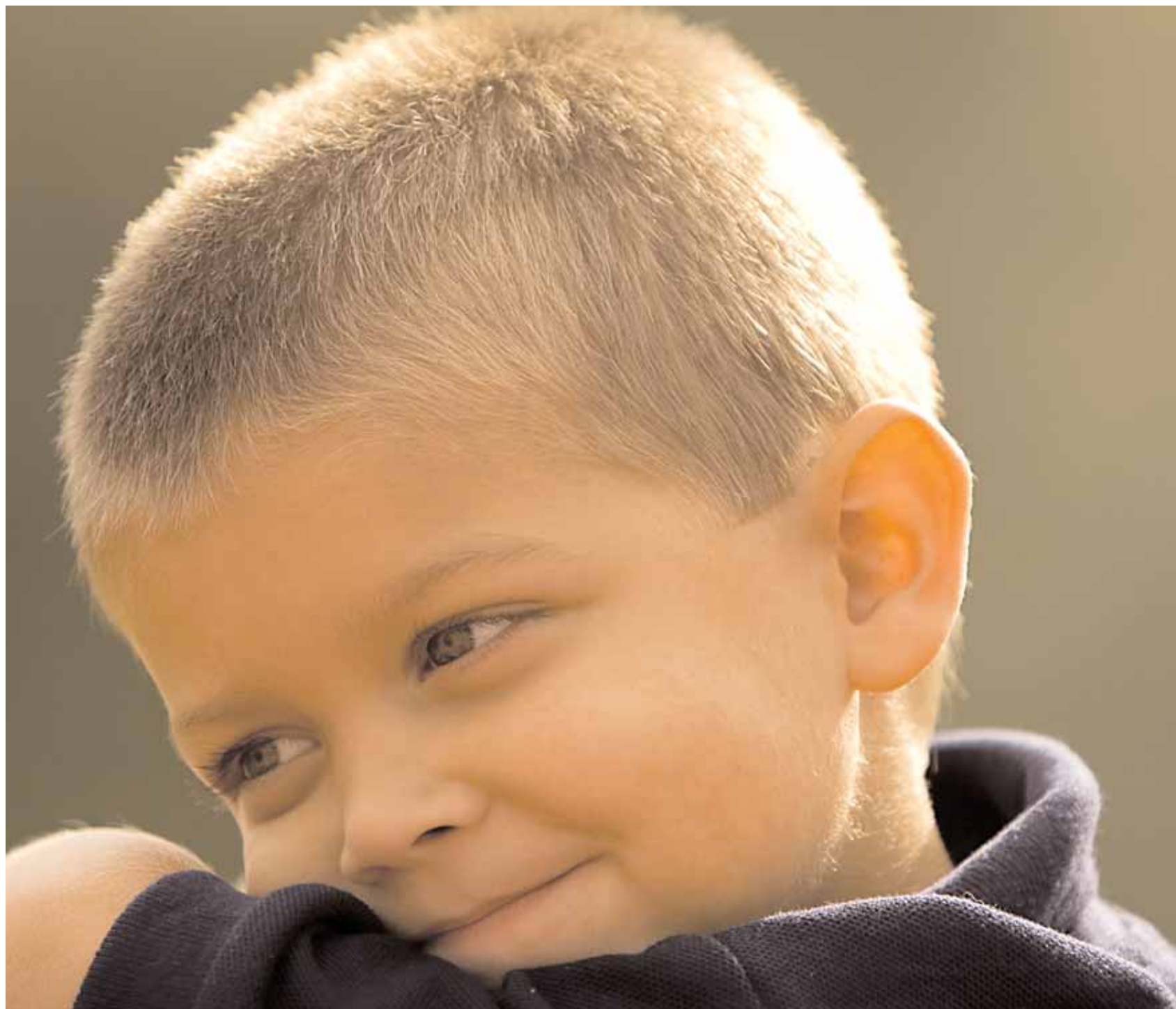

In the fall of 1989, Landmark opened its doors to 170 eager 7th-12th grade students in a downtown Fayetteville warehouse. Landmark soon outgrew this facility and in 1991 purchased the current campus, the former Campbell High School, in Fairburn. Landmark's Fairburn campus has grown to over 60 acres. In 2004, Landmark opened a second elementary school on 18 acres in Peachtree City.
